## SPORT PILOT CERTIFICATE TRAINING Airplane, Single Engine Land

Learning to fly requires learning a skill as well as aeronautical knowledge. Each individual comes to us with differing degrees of ability and skill sets. While the majority of flight students will finish in the allotted ground and flight-training times when they commit to a full time training schedule, not every student can or will do so.

**We are committed to helping you achieve your goal by training you to be a SAFE pilot. To do so usually takes people longer than the FAA's minimum 20 flight hours (Sport). Therefore, we have *not* based the training cost estimate on the FAA's minimum required training hours. In addition, we have included costs you should expect for FAA tests and associated exams provided by outside vendors.**
